This luncheon is complimentary and will be after the morning flyout / tour of the Waco Museum at Troy. It will be held at the New Carlisle, Andy Barnhart Memorial airport near Dayton, OH. There are several Waco's at the New Carlisle airport as well as many other interesting and vintage aircraft. Several of the hangars will be open for visitors and a lot of hangar flying will be available for everyone.

Ted will have a display of the various aircraft products that he produces and Roger will have some of his beautiful Waco cowlings and fairings on display as well. D&D Classics will also have a demonstration on metal forming for those interested.

New Carlisle (3OH0) is located 10 miles east of Dayton International Airport and 6 miles north of Wright Patterson AFB. Runway 9/27 has 2000 feet of grass available as well as a parallel 2000-foot hard surface runway. Roger's hangar is at the approach end of runway 27 and parking will be in the grass on the north side of his hangar. The CTAF is 122.9 and pattern altitude is 1700 feet MSL. Avgas is NOT available for transient aircraft.
